

9. And whereas the Government of Tamil Nadu, after confirming that the *vice versa* condition is acceptable to the Government of Pondicherry, have issued the following orders amending the G.O. (1D) No. 111, dated 31-5-2004 of the Higher Education(H1), Department of the Government of Tamil Nadu in their Letter *vide* (Ms.) No. 32, dated 1-2-2005 from the Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department, Secretariat, Chennai - 600 009, namely :—

- (i) As per the present practice, in cases of joint SLET, a candidate qualifying a joint SLET becomes eligible for lecturership in any of the participating States.
- (ii) The Government accepts the suggestion of the UGC regarding the *vice versa* condition that the candidates from Tamil Nadu /Pondicherry qualifying Tamil Nadu-Pondicherry Joint SLET will be eligible to become Lecturers in the State of Tamil Nadu and the Union Territory of Pondicherry ;

Now, therefore, approval of the Lieutenant - Governor, Pondicherry is hereby accorded for implementing the suggestion of the UGC regarding the *vice versa* condition that the candidates from Tamil Nadu/ Pondicherry qualifying Tamil Nadu-Pondicherry Joint SLET will be eligible to become Lecturers in the State of Tamil Nadu and the Union Territory of Pondicherry.

Balaji Theatre, Pondicherry, from the provisions of the sections 16 (1), 17 (1), 17 (2) and 18 of the Pondicherry Shops and Establishments Act, 1964 for conducting special morning show at 9.30 a.m. from 1-11-2005 to 4-11-2005 on account of screening a Tamil film, namely "Sivakkasi" subject to the following conditions:—

1. Every person employed shall be paid overtime wages for the period of work done by him in excess of 8 hours in a day or 48 hours in a week.
2. The total hours of work of each worker including overtime shall not exceed 10 hours including one hour of rest on any day or 54 hours in any week.
3. The management should obtain permission from the authorities concerned wherever necessary.

ORDER

The National Rural Health Mission is being implemented in the Union territory of Puducherry with the guidelines received from Government of India by entering into Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Government of India. The funding pattern has been fixed at 75:25 between Central and State Governments for implementation of the health activities. At the initial constitution the mission activities centered around rural poor and other deprived class of people who could not reach health

facilities situated in urban areas and receive quality health care through Government support. The National Rural Health Mission mainly covered RCH, Family Planning activities and other Disease Control Programmes which were previously running under the directions of Government of India as Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS).

2. Now, the Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has launched a new mission called National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) to improve the access of the urban poor to quality primary health care services. It was estimated by the Government of India that about 97 million people live in urban slums and due to rapid and increasing urbanization more and more people will live in slums. Realising the significant gap in availability of public health care to urban poor, the Government of India

has launched the National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) as a sub-mission under the overarching National Health Mission, the other sub-mission being the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM).

3. The National Urban Health Mission will cover all cities and towns with a population of more than 50,000 all District headquarters and State capitals. Towns with a population below 50,000 will be covered under NRHM. The NUHM would aim to improve the health status of the urban population in general, but particularly of the poor and other disadvantaged sections, by facilitating equitable access to quality health care through a revamped public health system, partnerships and community based mechanism with the active involvement of the urban local bodies.

4. The National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) would have high focus on:

(a) Urban poor population living in listed and unlisted slums.

(b) All other vulnerable population such as homeless, rag-pickers, street children, rickshaw pullers, construction and brick and lime kiln workers, sex workers and other temporary migrants.

(c) Public health thrust on sanitation, clean drinking water and vector control, etc.

(d) Strengthening public health capacity of urban local bodies.

5. The Government of Puducherry proposes to launch the National Urban Health Mission in the Union territory of Puducherry with 75% funding by Central Government and 25% funding by State Government. By launching the NUHM, the concept of the existing National Rural Health Mission has to be changed as National Health Mission (NHM) under which the two sub-missions *viz*, National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) and National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) will be functioning.

**ORDER**

The National Rural Health Mission is implemented in the Union territory of Puducherry as per the guidelines of Government of India and entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi. At the initial constitution the Mission activities centred around poor and other deprived class of people who could not reach health facilities situated in urban areas and receive quality health care through Government support. The National Rural Health Mission mainly covers reproductive and child health and family planning activities and other disease control programmes which were previously running under the directions of Government of India as Centrally Sponsored Schemes. Funding pattern has been fixed at 75:25 between Central and State Government for implementation of these health activities through National Rural Health Mission.

2. In the context of rapid urbanisation in India and realising the significant gap in availability of Public Health Care to urban poor and considering that 97 million people live in urban slums which figure would be increasing rapidly, Government of India has launched National Urban Health Mission to improve the access of the urban poor to quality primary health care.

3. The National Urban Health Mission will cover all the cities and towns with the population of more than 50,000 in all district headquarters and State capitals. Towns with a population of below 50,000 will be covered under National Rural Health Mission. While National Urban Health Mission would aim to improve the health status of the urban population in general and particularly of the poor and other disadvantaged sections by facilitating equitable access to quality health care through revamped public health system, having high focus on urban poor population living in listed and unlisted slums, vulnerable population such as homeless, ragpickers, street children, rickshaw-pullers, construction, brick and lime kiln workers, sex workers and other temporary migrants, the National Rural Health Mission will continue to concentrate its activities around the rural poor and also covering reproductive and child health, family planning and other disease control programmes.

4. In view of launching of the National Urban Health Mission as parallel programme to National Rural Health Mission, the activities of these two national programmes have been brought under the ambit of upgraded National Health Mission. The overarching

national health mission henceforth will be the focal centre for delivery of health care needs of the people in and other poor and disadvantaged sections in particular, through National Rural Health Mission and National Urban Health Mission.

5. The Government of Puducherry having subscribed to the national policy in providing accessible, affordable, effective and reliable health care of quality to all the citizens and in particular to the poor and vulnerable sections of the population and having entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with Ministry of Health and Family Welfare Services, New Delhi in this regard, has proposed to launch National Urban Health Mission in the Union Territory along with the existing National Rural Health Mission under the overarching National Health Mission and to continue delivery of health care through the National Rural Health Mission and National Urban Health Mission as the two sub-missions of National Health Mission.

6. Now, therefore, in supersession of G. O. Ms. No. 47, dated 25-6-2010, the Lieutenant-Governor of Puducherry is pleased to reconstitute the District Health Missions in Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam regions under National Rural Health Mission to exercise its power and functions under the revised concept of National Health Mission for identification of policy changes to be taken up with the State Health Mission, consideration and approval of plans/ proposals for submission to State Health Mission, consideration and approval of proposals with delegated powers, review of progress in all mission activities and advocacy of measures required to promote National Rural Health Mission and National Urban Health Mission and implementation/review, activity schedule of programme committees and follow-up on action of the decision of the State Health Mission as detailed below:
