

# **Flagship Programme – AB PMJAY**

## **Bullet Points of the Scheme:**

### **Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY):-**

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) was launched by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2018, at Ranchi, Jharkand.

This is the “World’s largest government funded healthcare program” targeting more than 50 crore beneficiaries.

AB-PMJAY will provide a cover of upto 5 lakhs per family per year, for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization.

Over 10.74 crore vulnerable entitled families (approximately 50 crore beneficiaries) will be eligible for these benefits:

- 1) Financial protection from catastrophic expenditure.
- 2) Hospitalization cover from inpatient care to post hospitalization care.

### **Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana in alliance with the States:**

States can implement the scheme through an insurance company or directly through the Trust / Society / Implementation Support Agency or a mixed approach.

This scheme is creating a cadre of certified frontline health service professionals called Pradhan Mantri Aarogya Mitras (PMAMS) who will be primary point of facilitation for the beneficiaries to avail treatment at the hospital and thus, act as a support system to streamline health service delivery.

### **The scheme involves the following:**

- Hospital Empanelment
- IT Systems update.

MoU has been signed with Common Service Centre (CSC) for Beneficiary Identification and will utilize the over 3 lakhs village level entrepreneurs for identifying beneficiaries.

Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is a paradigm shift from sectorial, segmented and fragmented approach of service delivery through various national and State schemes to a bigger, more comprehensive and better converged and need based service delivery of secondary and tertiary care.

### **Status of UT Puducherry:**

In UT Puducherry, *the implementation of AB-PMJAY was started in IGGGH&PGI on 31<sup>st</sup> August* by Hon'ble Chief Minister.

Around **1.97 lakhs families** have been identified under this scheme in UT of Puducherry.

**Common service centres (125 CSCs)** allocated for UT Puducherry to distribute e- cards.

- The Scheme was implemented for the I Year in Insurance Mode with Star Health and Allied Insurance Company Limited .
- For the II year it was implemented in Trust Mode with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> Dec 2020.
- From 13-01-2021 , 88917 beneficiaries of PMRS Scheme ( State Run Scheme) have been brought under ABPMJAY scheme with the same benefit of ABPMJAY beneficiaries of SECC-2011 and GO has been issued for the Convergence.

No. of Claims submitted as on 31-07-2021 is **2740cases** worth **Rs. 8818797-00**
